**3. New Business**

**a. End of year assessments**

Ms. Diaz shared a presentation informing parents about end of year assessments. K-1 will administer local measures assessments in Reading, Writing, and Math. In grades 2-8 teachers will administer Achieve level set, iReady Math, and CAASPP (ELA, Math, Science in 5<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup>). Students in Dual Immersion will take additional assessments in Spanish, such as Achieve level set and writing. Ms. Diaz also shared the testing window for the school and explained that every grade level will send out their specific testing calendar. Parent tips were shared to help students get prepared for testing as well as ways to help students deal with testing anxiety.

**b. LCAP Information**

Mr. MacGaffey informed parents about Discovery's LCAP. The goals in the LCAP may pertain to subgroups such as ELL's, homeless, low socio-economic. The goals keep students' best interests in mind and best practices for teaching. He shared how funds are used to pay for our VAPA program and teacher collaboration. The school received pandemic funds that were used to hire teacher aides in 1<sup>st</sup> grade to allow for small group instruction. Mr. MacGaffey shared that it is important to review LCAP, what works well, areas of improvement. He asked for parents to give their input through Thought Exchange and take time to answer one question: What do you appreciate at Discovery and what would you like to see improved? Ms. Alamo explained the process for using Thought Exchange and shared the link.
