- Mrs. Maritza Diaz, parent, spoke to the Board regarding the disconnect and miscommunication regarding after-school programs. Mrs. Diaz is concerned regarding the availability of our afterschool programs and would like more transparency on the subject.
- Mrs. Estee Howsare, parent, spoke to the Board regarding a lack of after school
 programs available for TK and Kindergarten students. She is also concerned
 regarding a balanced schedule for afterschool opportunities and offered
 coordination with volunteers for afterschool opportunities. She would also like to
 advocate for more vocational programs within Discovery from TK to Middle
 School, to help better prepare students for High School and College.

V. Executive Director's Report

(Information/Report)

- Mr. MacGaffey shared that during the unexpected power outage that we had today.
 students and staff did an amazing job of continuing the day and they were able to bring back power within the hour.
- Mr. MacGaffey excitedly reported that we are #2 in the district for our daily rate of attendance. Many covid cases continue to be reported, but our district and staff have been able to support these absences and Discovery is able to offer ISC's for those students who need it. Mr. MacGaffey and Mrs. Alamo have met with parents of students who have also been chronically absent and have offered more information and support to them.
- Our AthLEAD afterschool program is running well. We are receiving our funding
 for this program from ELOP and we have helped to also maintain attendance to
 ensure the funds are being used well. Sports tryouts are also coming up with
 AthLEAD.
- Mr. MacGaffey reported that teachers are finishing beginning of year assessments and data has started to come in, which helps us determine what supports and interventions are needed. Initial ELPAC testing is also underway.

Mr. MacGaffey also noted that we're having a great start to the new school year.
 We had our very first and well attended PTC meeting and we are gearing up for our family camp out.

VI. 2023 Discovery Data Report

(Information/Report)

- Mr. MacGaffey shared data on our reading and Math local measures, which
 included our achieve and iReady data. The students did a great job.
- The average lexile in both English and Spanish, continues to grow year after year.
- Our EL's and our students with disabilities grew in lexiles, a greater amount than
 all students which helps to narrow the gap in their lexile growth. Middle School
 students have also succeeded in their lexile growth, and they continue to be #1
 within the district in ELA and Math CAASPP scores.
- Mr. MacGaffey also shared data regarding our CAASPP and ELPAC scores. The CAASPP 2-year comparison showed great growth and areas to continue to work on.
- Our CAST Science scores are an area of focus for Discovery. There are future plans to adapt to the new CAST test.
- Mr. MacGaffey also reported that we are seeing the right trends on our ELPAC scores and continue to work on this target and our EL's are doing well.
- Our iReady math average scale scores are also growing.
